

## HIGHGATE FESTIVAL OPEN GARDENS 2021

**1. Mona's Garden, 33 Wood Vale N10 32DJ** This award winning garden is home to the Corokia National Collection as well as other unusual Southern Hemisphere and Mediterranean plants and many more. Emphasis on texture and shapes and leaf colour.

**2. Sophia's Garden, 9 View Rd, N6 4DJ [open 2-5pm\*]** A well stocked, informally planted front garden leads to a generous rear garden which the current owners have lovingly coaxed back from its wild, overgrown state.

**3. Harington Scheme, Cholmeley Cres, N6 5EH** Set up as a charity by the local community over thirty years ago, and located on a unique and beautiful site in Highgate.

**4. Ruth & Peter Benton's Garden, Duke's Head Yard, N6 5JL.** A traditional garden which is an oasis of tranquility behind busy Highgate High street. No parking in Duke's Head Yard. **Teas £2**, proceeds to St Michael's Church.

**5. Southwood Lodge, 33 Kingsley Place, N6 5EA [open 2-5pm\*]** Unusual plants, ponds, waterfall, frogs, toads, newts. Many topiary shapes formed from yew trees.

**6. Bunty's Garden, 3 The Park N6 4EU** A hidden treasure, transformed from a neglected wartime wilderness into a flowing series of gloriously abundant spaces, burgeoning with variety, colour and texture. **Plants and home-made jams for sale.**

**7. LUX Garden, Waterlow Park, N19 5JF** A delightful little hidden garden, entered through LUX. Films screening continuously 2-6 to celebrate late Scottish film-maker and poet Margaret Tait, followed at 6-7 with a promotion of her book 'Personae'.
