Saturday 13th June

It's the amazing Fair in the Square, but please also take time to visit an exhibition about 60 years of the work of the Highgate Society at the Highgate School Museum on Southwood Lane and the HLSI Open Day and Book Sale on South Grove. There is the Katya Apekisheva Piano Recital at the Red Hedgehog in the evening.

Then, either cross the Archway Road to the Red Hedgehog for the Petros Moschos Piano Recital or wander up to the village for the Historic Jewish Highgate walk starting opposite Lauderdale House.

Just time for a quick drink at one of our lovely pubs before joining us in Pond Square for some singing and dancing with Vikas and Bob, then a quick bite before An Actor's Lament Upstairs at the Gatehouse!

Saturday 20th June

Start the day with a visit to the wonderful new Highgate Newtown Community Centre and café with talks, tours, workshops, kids activities and Dr Bike. Wander up Swain's Lane for the Highgate Village Brocante in Pond Square or stop off at Waterlow Park for a cuppa or yoga on the Tea Lawn at Lauderdale House with Jo Jo Yoga

OR walk a little further to meet outside the Wrestlers to see a special performance of The Lost Girls of Highgate Cemetery on the Hillcrest Estate

After a drink or a bite, head up to Pond Square for the highlight of the Highgate Festival – the Community George Michael Sing-a-long. Join us to sing his iconic hits and celebrate his amazing life and legacy OR head down to the Red Hedgehog for an exhilarating evening of Cuban jazz popping into the Boogaloo beforehand for a discounted Holy Joe's pizza.

Start the day with a Gospel Brunch (kids eat free!) at the Boogaloo and drop your kids off at the KidsCreate Workshop. Then wander up to the village for the Poetry in Motion Walk, or find a spot on the Tea Lawn at Lauderdale House to listen to the Camden Music Jazz Group. There is also a Geotrail around Waterlow Park on offer.

Grab a drink as you join us for more music in Pond Square with local favourites The Archway Mountain Lightnin' Boys. Finally, join us for a special event created to end the festival – a walk and performance to commemorate the Londoners buried in the Highgate Plague Pit before retiring to the Boogaloo for a toast.
